To the Department of Justice:

On behalf of the Board of the Council of Fort Lauderdale Civic Associations (CFLCA) I am writing to support funding for the Fort Lauderdale Police Department Body Worn Camera Project. Body worn cameras are a promising tool that can be used to improve law enforcement interactions with the communities that they serve.
