Discussion on replacement of Fiveash water plant – PPP, unsolicited bids or open bid -  
Resolution Rejecting Unsolicited Proposals  
Motion Approving Proprietary Purchases for Water Distribution, Wastewater Collection,  
and Stormwater System Infrastructures and Treatment Facilities - Estimated Total Not to  
Exceed \$6.4 Million
- Stormwater – severe flooding due to heavy rains & king tides; storm and sewer utility  
systems working at full capacity.
- Utilities – Sewer break on Bayview Drive repaired -construction issues including  
overflow into canals seem to be resolved
- Infrastructure Updates – Bayview Dr closed south of Oakland Park Blvd and south of  
Commercial Blvd-New sewer line; Water main improvements in Lakes Estates, Bermuda  
Riviera,
- Economic Development & Impacts – small businesses still being impacted by low  
customer turnout due to Covid-19 as phase three opening begins.
- Police: Crime Concerns & Police Community Relations - **Coral Ridge** 1 Robbery, 2 each -  
residence, business, conveyance burglaries, auto theft; **Coral Ridge CC** – robbery 2, burglary  
residence 1, conveyance 3, vehicle theft 3, **Galt Mile** 1 burglary conveyance; **Imperial Point** 2  
burglary conveyance; **Landings** -1 each burglary residence, conveyance, 1 vehicle theft; **Palm  
Aire Villages** – 12 Burglary conveyance;
- Local Concerns: association communications, individuals, & local leaders

- Housing & Commercial Development –Valvoline Lube? Federal & NE 26 Street- New Holiday Inn Express at old motel location north of NE 26 St and Federal on west side of street
- Sober Homes & Vacation Rentals – continues to be a problem in Imperial Point;
- Transportation – Executive Airport - Runway and mid-field taxiway extension ; Roadway improvements in Twin lakes
- Education – concerns regarding Bayview school opening although school is open; Avionics program planned at Executive to expand to aerospace industry
- Parks – George English upgrades to boat ramp; Residents asking for Pickleball courts at George English. Cypress Creek Sand Pine Preserve conservation site (Cypress Creek Road near airport); preliminary discussion on Laudertrail walking and biking pathway continues with effort to include District 1. Commissioner Moraitis co-chairs working group with Commissioner Sorenson. Air show November 21-22
- Code Enforcement – concerns over response to vacation rentals
- City's Overall Direction Equity - Inter Miami to distribute food to neighbors in need
