**Introduction of Guests:**

- **City Manager Chris Lagerbloom** – City Updates
  - HP testing converted to vaccine & appointment system is not functioning well & is being used as overflow and sometimes without appointment if qualify. Park capacity issues may cause pauses. Lockhart is also vaccine site. Mills Pond still does testing. Rapid test Hard Rock and CBSmith. EMS & front line w/o access q's asked to qualify.
  - State has asked based on supply to only do 500/day per site to make sure have 2<sup>nd</sup> batch in 21 days. Sites designed to get scaled bigger to total 2,500/day vaccine in our City.
  - Haz. Waste- scheduling will get report back w/ answer
  - Off road drag race- FLPD is working ops. Plan (defer to Sousa)
  - Budget process working and chief search in progress no elaboration
  - DC events and racial equity initiative- strive to be welcoming, diverse, supportive city working on education campaign staff/leadership/other cities. Retained Bill Hawthorn who will begin working 2/1 former equity officer Macy's Chief Equity Officer City of Atlanta working here to explore, expose, improve.
- **Dr. JJ Rajter, Critical Care Medicine Specialist and Pulmonologist** – COVID Updates
  - Cases increasing nationwide mortality not quite as high. FL increasing cases since Sept., vaccines to: frontline & @risk, most sites here using Pfizer vaccine, less than 1/2 of vaccines have been utilized yet it's the logistics that's time consuming.
  - Without 2<sup>nd</sup> dose may not have long term response and won't have full response
  - Just because you get vaccine and wait set amount of time You are **NOT immune**

from COVID reduce chance of getting severe COVID continue masking, distancing, wash hands, etc. Yes you can continue to spread after you get vaccines per CDC, NIH, and Ast. And Pfz.

- Q's not clear if get 1<sup>st</sup> shot at HP if guaranteed to get 2<sup>nd</sup> dose. DOH/City Q for better answer. Vaccines are not the same so you need the same when getting 2<sup>nd</sup>.
- Vaccines & mutations- Pfizer looked at 2 mutations and appears to protect but that's an evolving analysis.
- What's best? 1<sup>st</sup> take what you can get, take #'s stated as effective w/ grain of salt disagrees 80%+ effective and splitting hairs to choose any of them over another.
- People who should not get vaccine? No studies on pregnancy due to risk, HIV see no reason not too, severe allergies overseas have said no in US they monitor at sight after you get to look for the serious reactions.
- 21 & 28 days does it need to be exact? A few days doesn't make difference they say this b/c this was how study was designed. Don't get this vaccine and any other within 2 weeks of each other based on study. But okay if happens.
- Expectation for more vaccines a year or so after have 2 data not here yet but based on other things you have to get other versions in future.
