Introduction of Guests:

- **City Manager Chris Lagerbloom** – City Updates - Spring break is winding down. COVID numbers are better with two sites available in the city of Ft Lauderdale. Miami soccer team is opening this weekend. Home opener (Montreal) about 8000 fans expected in the stands. One stop shop: public projects must meet certain criteria. If project moves forward public must be informed prior to. We still have time. Impact fee ordinance: Must be utilized in the area it was collected for and distance requirements must be met. Discussion continues on Bahia Mar to allow certain developments. We don't want to see the property sit for another 40 years. Vacancies are being filled at the police department. Need to have a diversity balance for candidates.
- **Dr. JJ Rajter** - Covid Updates - Things are kind of steady and cases are up but not dramatically. CDC recommended that the state of Michigan go in lock down because numbers are high. We are not out of the woods yet get vaccinated and be careful. There is a chance of getting COVID 19 even after being vaccinated. Best vaccine is the one in your arm.
