

## Report of the Legislative Committee

The Legislative Committee met February 22 2022 and forwarded the following bills to the Board. The 2022 Legislative Session ends on March 11. Bills that pass both chambers will go to the Governor for signing.

1. **CS/SB 518** Private Property Rights to Prune, Trim, and Remove Trees (establishes professional standards and defines residential property)
2. **CS/HB105** amends the FCIAA to allow counties and municipalities to restrict smoking within the boundaries of any public beach or park they own.
3. **SB512** Vacation Rentals. Support Florida League of Cities comments which incorporate concerns of our Code Enforcement Division
4. **HB 2753** Fort Lauderdale Community Court by LaMarca  
Provides an appropriation for the Fort Lauderdale Community Court  
Effective Date: July 1, 2022
5. **HB 3755** Fort Lauderdale Tarpon River Environmental/Maintenance Dredging by LaMarca  
Provides an appropriation for the Fort Lauderdale Tarpon River Environmental/Maintenance Dredging –  
Effective Date: July 1, 2022
6. **HB 4323** Fort Lauderdale Melrose Manors Stormwater Project by Williams  
Provides an appropriation for the Fort Lauderdale Melrose Manors Stormwater Project:  
Effective Date: July 1, 2022
7. **SB1702/HB7069** Would establish building inspection requirements for the whole state (currently just Miami-Dade, Broward and I heard Palm Beach just adopted something).
