1. Officially recognized neighborhoods will be featured on the City's website and a link to the neighborhood associations web page will be included.
2. Qualified to be a voting member on Fort Lauderdale's [Council of Fort Lauderdale Civic Associations](#).
3. One parking permit will be provided to each recognized association for free parking in city employee parking spaces in the City Hall Garage.
4. 500 NCIP points for participating in officially recognized volunteer events.
5. Complimentary printing for neighborhood association sponsored events (some limitations apply).
6. Eligible for Neighbor Support Night's "Neighborhood of the Year" award.
7. Eligibility for Green Your Routine (GYR) points through various initiatives.
8. Access to meeting space in city facilities as available.
