Should I Stay, or Should I Go?: Evaluating the Role of Climate and Weather Stressors on Moving Decisions In Southeast Florida

About this Study:

This study will analyze how South Floridians are experiencing and responding to climate and weather stressors (i.e., floods, extreme heat, hurricanes), and how these stressors are potentially influencing residential moving decisions. Participants will take a short online screening survey prior to participating in an online focus group session.

You are eligible if you are:

- 18 years or older
- A current or past resident (within 5 years) of one of the following neighborhoods:
 - Edgewood
 - River Oaks
 - Croissant Park
 - Shady Banks
 - Sailboat Bend
- Are a homeowner or have owned a home in the above neighborhoods
- Available for a 12-question survey followed by an approximately 45-minute online focus group
