General Membership Meeting Minutes June 8, 2026

Recording Secretary **Suzi Burstein** called the meeting to order.

FLPD Update

- Officer Andy provided an update on preparations for the FIFA World Cup, including increased police staffing, regional law enforcement coordination, and anticipated impacts from increased visitor activity and traffic throughout the region.

Sustainability Presentation

- Sylvia Duque Anez presented the Private Property Resiliency Outreach Program, designed to help residents and neighborhood associations improve resilience to flooding, sea level rise, and extreme heat through education, outreach, and community resources.

Treasurer's Report

- Treasurer Carlos Lang reported a May account balance of **\$5,724.17**.
- Thirty-two neighborhood associations are currently in good standing.
- Efforts continue to recruit additional member associations.

Letter of Support for City Manager Rickelle Williams

- A quorum was established in accordance with the CFLCA bylaws.
- Treasurer Carlos Lang read the proposed letter of support aloud, and the letter was displayed for members.
- A motion was made and a vote conducted among eligible member associations.
- The motion passed by a vote of **16-1**.

Charter Revision Amendment Questions

- Members discussed the proposed charter revision questions approved for placement on the ballot.
- It was noted that no additional questions may be added due to ballot deadlines.
- Concerns were raised regarding the timing of the charter questions and whether sufficient time would be available for voter outreach and public education.
- Members requested a plain-language summary and bullet-point guide explaining each charter revision question for public distribution.

Community Announcements

- The City's July 4 celebration will include a concert, fireworks display, and drone show.
- **Jorg Hruschka Day** will be held as a free community event celebrating his retirement and more than 30 years of service.

- A leadership transition was announced at the Imperial Point Civic Association, with Betty Shelley stepping down and Laura assuming representation.
